My dear Mother Father & Sister

I suppose you were all quite surprised to hear about me being hit. I sent you one field card from Ruesen and another one just as we were arriving in Southampton.

My wound is not serious, it is on the left upper arm and is quite a nasty looking affair but as it did not strike the bone it will soon be all right.

Murray & I were together when I got hit so I do not know how he is. I surely hope and pray he come through the big scrap all right if our camp are by the date Aug 8. when I was hit, when the big drive started up around Arras that I did not go very far. But this is a story that will have to wait. until I get out of Bed I am looking forward to seeing some Red & Ladies now so I can get a proper rest as I have lost everything I owned will write you tomorrow Bob
